1. UNIVERSITY COLLEGES OF MERIT IPE

L'IPE (Institute for education and research) is a non-profit organisation that promotes various educational and cultural activities for young people. Its goal is to expose them to culture, education and the world of work. I.P.E. runs three "Collegi Universitari di Merito (Villalta, Monterone and Poggiolevante)" which are accredited by the Ministry of Education, University and Research:



2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The following category of both Italian and foreign students can participate in announcement of public examination for the academic year 2022/2023:

✓	Those who will enrol o will have already enrolled in an undergraduate programme.
✓	Those who will enrol or will have already enrolled in a postgraduate programme (specialization).
✓	Those who are the winners of a competition for university PhD courses or research grants
✓	Those who are enrolled at Master level, university Master or are accredited for ASFOR
✓	Those who are enrolled in "Istituzioni dell'Alta Formazione Artistica, Musicale e Coreutica riconosciute dal Ministero" (AFAM)

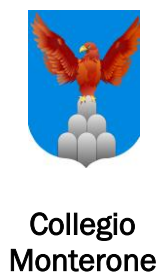
3 OUR SERVICES

Students, who live in the college, can avail of the following services:

3.1. Residential services

Type of Room	Single, double ore triple single/triple with bathroom All rooms have air condition
Housekeeping	4 days per week. Common areas 5 days per week
Linen Services	Weekly change of bathroom towels and every two weeks of bedlinen
Meals	Complete board 7 days per week
Reception	Without time restriction with opening badge.
General and Didactic Services	Full coverage WiFi, Study rooms, tutor rooms, workshop, library, periodical collection, informatics room and lecture room
OtherFacilities	Music room, sitting and TV room, multimedia room, garden , small gym and parking (motorbikes and bicycles)

Meals	Full board: breakfast, lunch, snacks and dinner. There is also the possibility to have a packed lunch
Access	Without time restriction with personal code

3.2 Educational Services

 Counselling and Mentoring	<p>Identification and creation of a personalized training path¹ through individual interviews with the management staff</p>
 Tutorship & Coaching	<p>Tutoring activities on chosen university path and on exams with professors, researches, doctoral students and professionals</p>
 Internationalisation	<p>Orientation for exchange programmes (Erasmus and Overseas) and internationalisation programmes (summer schools, work experience, internship and conferences)</p>
 Career Service	<p>Orientation and introduction to the world of work through individual interviews and group activities (opportunities for undergraduate and internship graduates, meetings with professionals, workshops on transversal skills and training workshops)</p>
 Cultural Activities	<p>Cultural in-depth activities through national thematic workshops and integrative interdisciplinary courses</p>
 Community	<p>Opportunities for discussions and sharing of ideas with other students and management staff through activities such as meeting and themed conversations (also with guests), sports and cultural tips</p>
 ASIRID (Poggiorelevante - Bari)	<p>Poggiorelevante College offers training activities for scientific and technical degree course students (only for the three- year period) in the context of the International Residential School of Digital Innovators.</p>
 ACCADEMIA (Monterone, Villalta - Napoli)	<p>IPE Academy organizes interdisciplinary courses for students of all faculties: teaching activities cover specific subject from different areas of interest (Law, Medicine, Economics, Engineering, the Art) and the development of transversal skills (topical issues, global vision, leadership, soft skills)</p>
 Soft Skill	<p>Training activities for public speaking problem solving and team work so as to develop personal qualities, improve workplace behaviour and implement knowledge in the field of interpersonal relationships</p>

Moreover, all colleges offer the possibility to freely participate in activities related to spiritual and doctrinal formation, which are inspired by the principles of the Catholic Church and entrusted to the Prelature of Opus Dei.

4. ANTI COVID-19 SECURITY MEASURES

Within the Collegi IPE, all the security measures established by sector legislation aimed at containing the spread of the COVID-19 virus are respected. To this end, the Colleges are equipped with a Safety Protocol drawn up on the basis of the assessment of specific risks.

The conditions for applying for a scholarship grant are as follows:

- be admitted to one of the IPE Colleges,
- be enrolled at the Universities of Bari or Naples, for degree courses, specializations, masters and research doctorates,
- be enrolled in the Institutions of Higher Artistic, Musical and Choral Training of Bari or Naples, recognized by the Ministry.

In the event of students residing in the college for periods less than one academic year, fees are calculated based on the number of months stayed (e.g. Erasmus students).

Scholarships and grants

With the purpose of promoting access to the colleges to young gifted students without the economic burden of full fees, I.P.E. offers a number of scholarships and grants. The issuing of **these** scholarships and grants, **which can be combined with that of income**, do not consist of direct payments but a reduction of the annual fee from a minimum of €1,000 to a maximum of €2,000 per year according to the following table:

The requirements for scholarships and grants are:

- ✓ be admitted to one of the IPE Boards and enrolled at the University of Bari or Naples, for degree courses, specialisation, master and research doctorates; be enrolled in the institutions of Higher Artistic, Musical and Choral Training of Bari or Naples, recognized by the Ministry;
- ✓ By July 27, 2022, university students from second year on must have achieved at least 50% of the ECTS of their degree program for the academic year 2022-2023, and the average requested by the MIUR for the "Collegi Universitari di Merito". For graduates, it is necessary to have completed the graduation programme within the specified period time and to have graduated no more than two years from October 31, 2022.

Special Scholarships

In order to encourage foreign student participation in the I.P.E. colleges, Master's, ASIRID Project, students and graduates with particular conditions defined by specific agreements between I.P.E. and different Universities, scholarships will be awarded up to a maximum of €5.000 per year according to the following table. **The special scholarship cannot be combined with scholarships for income and merit.**

The requirements for scholarships and grants are:

- ✓ Be admitted to one of the IPE boards;
- ✓ Meet one of the following conditions:
 1. **Foreign students:** be enrolled at the University of Bari or Naples, for degree courses, specialisation, master and research doctorates or be enrolled in the Institutions of Higher Artistic, Musical and Choral Training of Bari or Naples, recognized by the Ministry;
 2. **IPE Master's student:** be admitted to the IPE School;
 3. **Special conventions:** meet the conditions set by the agreement.

The granting of the aforementioned scholarships will take place until the total amount assigned for scholarships and grants by IPE is exhausted.

Other concessions

For new students admitted to the Colleges that have siblings who are already resident in the colleges, it is possible to take advantage of a 15% discount on the monthly. **This facility cannot be combined with any other type of I.P.E., INPS and ENMPAM scholarship.**

6. GRANTS, BURSARIES and CONVENTIONS WITH INPS

In convention with INPS, grants are available for students whose parents work for the civil service and for students who are orphans of former civil service employees, respecting the parameters stipulated for the academic year 2022-2023 in the document "Collegi Universitari" which is available on the INPS website. The grant provided by INPS **can cover up to 100% of the annual fee.** The beneficiaries of the above-mentioned grant will be nominated directly by INPS and cannot be contested. **Nonetheless, they must pass IPE admission procedure.** The INPS grant cannot be combined with any other facilities.

7. SCHOLARSHIP WITH EMPAM

EMPAM gives students the opportunity to have scholarships in order to reside in the IPE colleges. The EMPAM contribution can determine a reduction of up to €5,000.00 euro for year.

The assignment of the scholarship is restricted to the admission to the Colleges and its benefit cannot be combined with any other one.

8. REQUEST FOR ADMISSION AND REQUEST FOR APPLICATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

10. ADMISSION TEST

The test includes a review of qualifications, aptitude tests and admission interviews with the management of the individual Colleges.

Admissions are up to the discretion of the Directorate of the College up until all available places have been exhausted.

Offers of acceptance will be issued by e-mail within 7 days from the date of the selection process.

11. REAPPOINTMENT

In order to be reappointed in the Collegio for the next academic year, you must meet the following conditions:

1. Have passed an evaluation by the college Directors
2. Have achieved the 50% of ETCS of the current accademic year, within the 27th of July, 2023.
3. Have got the academic year- average required by the MIUR for the “Collegi Universitari di Merito”
4. Have achieved the number of hours of training established in the Personal Training Project
5. Have paid the first fee within the 28th of July, 2023.

12. CONTRACT OF RESIDENCE

The relationship between the student and the College is governed by an annual contract of residence that stipulates the economic and stay conditions. **The minimum period of stay is 4 months.**

The signing of the aforementioned contract allows the parents of students residing outside of their place of residence to benefit from tax deductions.
