1. IPE UNIVERSITY CAMPUSES OF MERIT

The IPE (Institute for Educational Research and Activities) is a non profit entity whose purpose is to promote formation and education by giving young professionals access to higher educational formation, cultural learning and work. IPE operates three University Campuses of Merit (hereafter: Campus), recognized and accredited by the Ministry of University and Research:



2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The following categories of students are eligible to participate in the A.Y. 2023/2024. The students who are:

- a) intend to enroll or are already enrolled in university courses
- b) intend to enroll or are already enrolled in university specialization courses
- c) winners of research grants for university doctoral courses
- d) are enrolled in Master, University Master's or ASFOR accredited courses
- e) are enrolled or intend to enroll in Institutions of Higher Education in Arts, Music e Dance recognized by the Ministry (AFAM)

<u>The Training Program requires mandatory completion of at least 70 or 25 hours of training based on the year of university enrollment.</u>

In addition, in all campuses there is the possibility to participate, freely, in spiritual and doctrinal formation activities inspired by the principles of the Catholic Church and entrusted to the Prelature of Opus Dei.

4. IPE FEE AND SCOLARSHIPS

The annual fee, calculated in ten monthly payments, for individual Campuses is set as:

In the case of students who reside in the Campuses for period of less than the academic year, then the fee should be paid in proportion to the months of actual stay (e.g. Erasmus students).

<u>IPE provides its foreign students with special Scholarships that don't result in a direct</u> <u>disbursement to the student, but rather a IPE fee deduction.</u>

Recognition of a Scholarship is contingent upon admission to one of IPE's Campuses and enrollment at the Universities of Bari or Naples, for bachelor's degree, master's and doctoral programs/enrollment at Institutions of Higher Education in Arts, Music and Dance in Bari or Naples, recognized by the Ministry (including for Erasmus Projects or other Programs for foreign students).

The allocation of the above scholarships shall be made up to the capacity of the Fund specially allocated by the IPE.

FOREIGNERS SCHOLARSHIP is set as 4.500 € for year (450 €/month).

5. ADMISSION AND SCOLRASHIP APPLICATIONS

6.ADMISSION TEST

Admission to the Campuses is by examination of qualifications, tests and by interview with the management staff.

Admission is arranged at the sole discretion of the Campus Management staff until all available seats are filled.

Notification of admission is made by e-mail within 7 days after the selection is held.

7. RENEWAL

For the purpose of renewal of stay in the campus for the next academic year, the following requirements must be met:

1. Having passed an interview with the management staff

2. Having achieved the number of mandatory training hours mentioned in the Personal Training Program

3. Pay the first installment by July 28, 2024

Renewal is considered on the basis of the unquestionable judgment of the Management.

8. HOSPITALITY CONTRACT

The relationship between the student and the Campus is governed by the annual hospitality contract bearing the economic and residence conditions. The minimum length of stay is four months.

Entering into the hosting contract allows for tax deductions recognized for off-site students in accordance with current tax regulations.
